ANGER

1. The Lord is able to comfort us in times of grief and sorrow. (Psalm 23, 91:1-2, Deuteronomy 32:10-12)
2. Present sufferings cannot compare with our coming glory. (Romans 8:18)
3. All things work together for our good. (Romans 8:28)
4. Nothing can separate us from the love of God. (Romans 8:38-39)
5. One day this life of suffering will be over. (Revelation 21:1-4)

DEATH

1. We can face death without fear. (Psalm 23:4)
2. The believer will dwell in God's house forever. (Psalm 23:6, John 14:1-4)
3. The death of a saint is precious to the Lord. (Psalm 116:15)
4. Jesus died so that we may live forever with Him. (1 Thessalonians 5:9-11)
5. All who believe in Jesus will have eternal life. (John 3:14-16, 3:36, I John 5:11-12)

FEAR

1. Believers need not be slaves to fear. (Romans 8:15, 2 Timothy 1:7)
2. Don't be afraid because God cares for us. (Matthew 10:29-30)
3. Perfect love drives out fear. (1 John 4:18)

FINANCE

1. The Lord gives us power to get wealth. (Deuteronomy 8:18)
2. Wealth and riches are in your house. (Psalm 112:3)
3. Obedience to God brings blessings. (Deuteronomy 28:2-6)
4. When you give it is given to you. (Luke 6:38)
5. Don't be a God robber. (Malachi 3:8-11)

PRAYER

1. The model prayer. (Matthew 6:9-13)
2. We can approach God boldly through Jesus. (Hebrews 4:14-16)
3. Pray about everything instead of worrying. (Philippians 4:6-7)
4. Pray continually and give thanks in all circumstances. (1 Thessalonians 5:17-18)
5. God hears and answers prayer. (Psalm 34:15-18)

6. Praise and thank God for answered prayer. (Psalm 66:17-20)

TEMPTATION

1. Satan subtly tempted Eve. (Genesis 3:1-4)
2. Satan at times comes as an angel of light. (2 Corinthians 11:14-15)

WORRY

1. Jesus instructs us not to worry about tomorrow. (Matthew 6:25-34)
2. Don't be anxious but pray. (Philippians 4: 6-7)
3. Cast your anxiety on the Lord. (1 Peter 5: 6-7)
4. Anxiety weighs a person down. (Proverbs 12:25, 14:30, 17:22)
